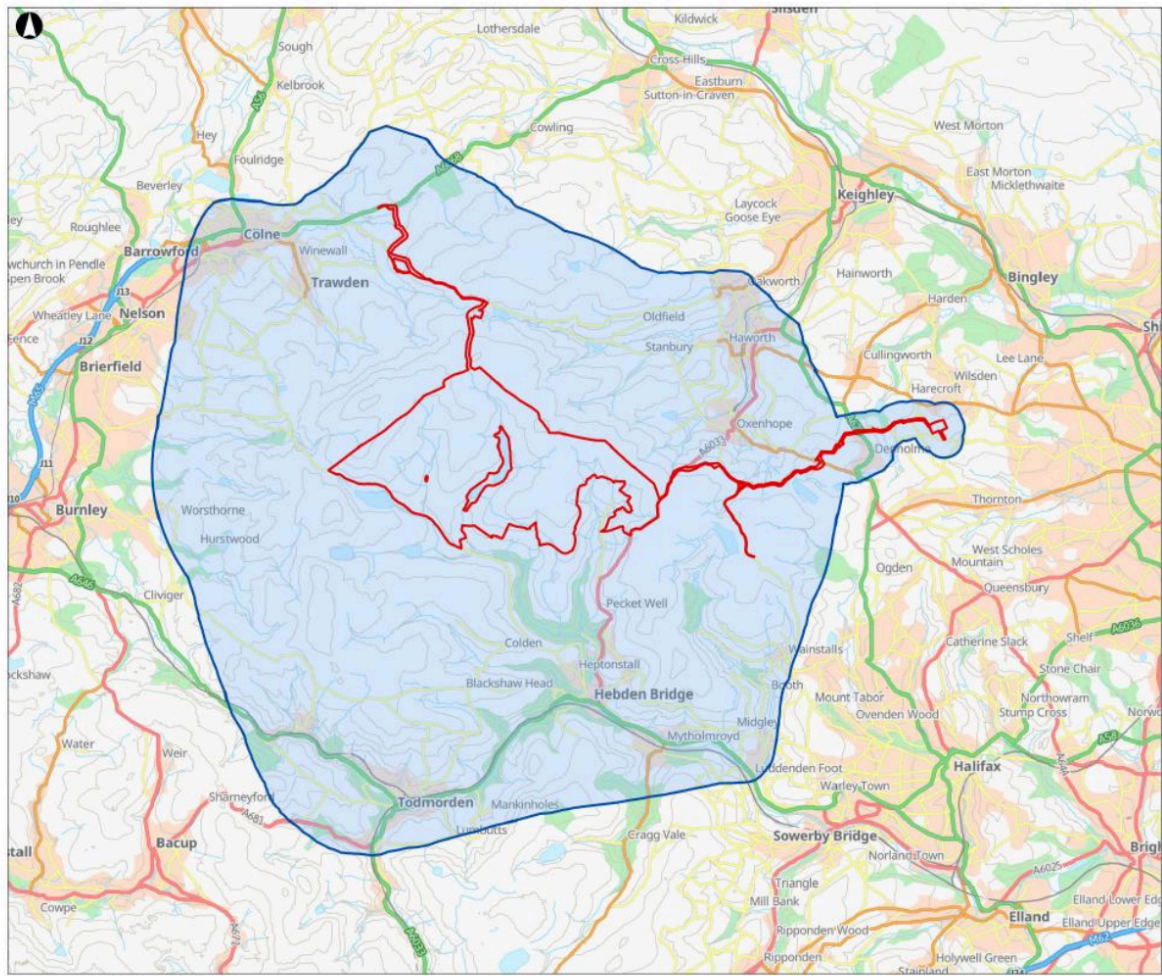

The developers state that notification of the statutory consultation will be sent to:

- All households and businesses that fall within the PCZ;
- Statutory Consultees identified under Section 42 of the PA 2008, which includes prescribed bodies such as Natural England and the Environment Agency, local authorities, and parties with an interest in land;
- Host or neighbouring Parish and Town Councils that meet the statutory relevance test in accordance with the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009;
- Members of Parliament representing communities or constituencies within and bordering the PCZ;

- Elected representatives in local authorities within the PCZ and;
- Relevant local interest groups, such as residents' associations, community groups and groups with particular specialisms, such as environmental groups.
